

## Important Information for Tour Participants



- 1. The facilities being toured are currently in operation. Certain hazards and exposures exist while on site. The employee guiding the tour will limit exposure to such hazards but cannot guarantee the extent of the exposure. Anne Arundel County is not responsible for any exposure that may occur while visiting the facilities.
- 2. Not all facilities are handicapped accessible.
- 3. For security reasons, backpacks are not allowed in the facilities. Storage for belongings will not be provided. Please secure belongings prior to entering the facility.
- 4. Wear flat, closed-toe shoes with non-slip soles. Open-toe shoes (i.e., flip flops, sandals, etc.) will not be permitted.
- 5. Dress for the weather.
- 6. Use of protective eyewear is mandatory. Safety glasses will be supplied prior to the beginning of the tour. Prescription eyeglasses meet this requirement.
- 7. Participants will not be allowed to participate in the tour if dressed inappropriately.
- 8. Any item that could be dropped (i.e., cell phones, pens, purses, etc.) or anything that could be caught in moving parts are not allowed for safety reasons.
- 9. Participants are asked to refrain from leaning on hand/guard rails when observing process and equipment operation.
- 10. Respectful and safety-conscious behavior is expected of all attendees, including attentiveness and appropriate conduct while on County property.
- 11. All participants 18 or older must provide a photo Identification (passport for international visitors) upon arrival that will be compared to the participant roster provided in advance. A copy of identification will be kept on file.
- 12. Photography may be prohibited at the discretion of the facility manager.
- 13. Parking is limited. Please plan on carpooling to the facility.
- 14. Participants will be asked to leave the facility if they are not adhering to the policy.
